

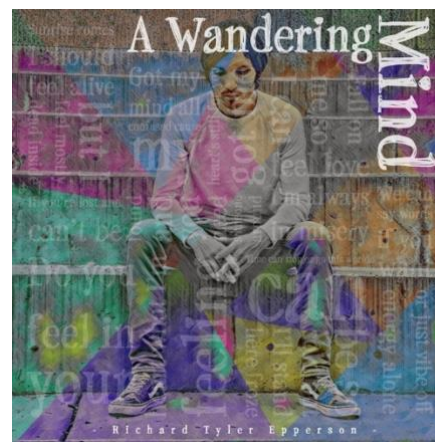

A Wandering Mind opens with “*Sunrise*” showcasing **Epperson’s** ability to musically stretch out into new sonic territories with rise and falls that creates a vivid cinematic feel that addresses how difficult a new day can be when dealing with depression. “*The inspiration behind sunrise comes from that feeling you get when you’re caught in between the sadness/numbness faze of depression,*” says **Epperson**. “*When you’re stuck in that dark place, you hope the new day will bring light, but if or when it doesn’t, it can feel unbearable.*” Following *Sunrise*, is the standout dynamic track, “*2AM*” that addresses the heart break associated with a once good relationship that has now gone bad. **Epperson** pulls you into the emotional sleepless night wondering where things went wrong.
